- You serve as an advisor for student programming at the board level.
- You represent ASPIRA of IL as the student rep on the National ASPIRA Association Board.
- You are the face that represents Aspirantes from all walks of life and will assist with the activities of the Aspira Alumni Association.

## To be eligible to serve as the College Student Representative on the Board of Directors, a student must:

- Have graduated from one of the ASPIRA Charter Schools or participated in an ASPIRA program, and
- is currently a full-time undergraduate matriculated student in good academic and disciplinary standing
- demonstrate a true interest in the organization and have leadership potential
- be a responsible, conscientious student with good organizational and communication skills
- be able to serve a term defined by two consecutive academic years
- available to attend all meetings and activities of the board of directors.
- pass a criminal background check as required by the Chicago Public Schools.
